

NOUNS

Concrete Nouns - nouns that we can see or touch (tangible)

EX: football, swimmer, bowl, SRMS, Chili's

Abstract Nouns – ideas or feelings (*intangible*, meaning they cannot be touched or seen)

EX: happiness, freedom, justice, kindness, respect

Common Nouns – refer to a general person, place or thing and lack details

EX: boy, town, highway, desert, team

Proper Nouns – specific nouns that name something and are always capitalized

EX: Vail, University of Colorado, *The Denver Post*, "The Office," Black Eyed Peas

Make your writing more interesting with nouns that are *specific* and provide more details.
